IS AN INITIATIVE OF



The Institute for Canadian Citizenship (ICC) invites all of Canada's public museums and galleries to participate in the **Cultural Access Pass** program that was launched in April 2008.

By participating in the program each museum/gallery would offer each individual adult new citizen (18 and over) and his/her children (17 and under) free access to its venue for one year from the day the new citizen is sworn in.

Citizenship and Immigration Canada (the "CIC") is a full partner in this program as it presents the program to new citizens at citizenship ceremonies.

Participating museums & galleries may also be the regional pick-up location, where new citizens collect their pass.

Participating museums/galleries design outreach events and projects (e.g. guided tours) that help new citizens become familiar with their venues, collections and exhibits, programs, volunteer opportunities, and ultimately membership experience.
